POPE FRANCIS REST IN PEACE: Pope Francis was born Jorge Maria Bergoglo in Argentina on the 17th December 1936 the son of Italian immigrations. He was elected the 266th pontiff on Wednesday 13th March 2013.

Cardinal Kevin Farrell, Camerlengo of the Holy Roman Church, announced the very sad news that the 88-year-old Pope Francis passed away at his residents in the Vatican on Easter Monday 21 April 2025. He said in his eulogy "The entire life of Pope Francis was dedicated to the service of the Lord and of His Church. He taught us to live the values of the Gospel with fidelity, courage, and universal love, especially in favour of the poorest and most marginalized. With immense gratitude for his example as a true disciple of the Lord Jesus, we commend the soul of Pope Francis to the infinite merciful love of the One and Triune God.

In his homily at the Requiem Mass for Pope Francis on Saturday 26th April, Cardinal Giovanni Battista Re said "He was a Pope among the people, with an open heart towards everyone, especially the marginalised, the least among us, but also a Pope attentive to the signs of the times and what the Holy Spirit was awakening in the Church"

Archbishop Mark O'Toole said, "I give thanks to God for having witnessed such an exceptional shepherd of the Church. By the manner of his life, Pope Francis has always challenged me to be a better, more faithful disciple of Jesus Christ. He first gave his life to God when he felt lovingly gazed upon, and called by God's mercy. We now entrust him into the merciful hands of the Lord, whom he has served most faithfully and generously. We accompany him with our prayers on this final journey he makes to the home of the Father."
